

## TRADING WITH EGYPT



**Exporters/Importers trading** in Food and Food Contact **Material Products with the** Arab Republic of Egypt need to comply with the requirements of the National Food Safety Authority (NFSA) in order to clear their Consignments by NFSA Officials on its arrival at the Egyptian Ports/Borders. Consignments of specific food categories and food contact materials supplied from specific countries of supply to the Republic of Egypt shall require a Certificate of **Inspection demonstrating** compliance to NFSA

This programme aims, under the supervision and management of the NFSA, to provide safe food products to consumers as well as a fast and direct Customs clearance of imported foods since the consignments will be verified and certified at the country of supply and allow its clearance through a fast track process based on Risk Assessment if presented with the Col.



Categories include Wheat, Oils, Rice, Sugar, Milk & Dairy Products, Preserved or Dried Fruits, Oils & Fats, Sugar Confectionary, Chocolate and Food preparations containing cocoa, Fruit Juices, Natural, Mineral and Soda Water, Food Contact Materials, Production Inputs (includes raw materials, intermediate goods, additives, flavouring agents, processing aids and food-contact packaging materials, identified and confirmed as destined for the purpose of further processing in Egypt).

Specified food and food contact product consignments may be subject to audit, inspection and testing prior to shipment.

Col - Certificate of Inspection

Exporters and importers will need to ensure that food products and food contact materials for the Egyptian market are fully compliant with Food law and regulations for quality, safety and suitability.

Importers and exporters will also have to ensure that their suppliers understand the quality, safety and suitability requirements for food products.

To obtain this Certificate of Inspection, food consignments will be subject, at the country of supply, to Inspection verification, Product Testing, documentary review and consignment sealing, where applicable.
