

## USE OF THE SWEDAC SYMBOL BY CERTIFIED CLIENTS

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### Management System Certification - Medical

The purpose of this document is to ensure proper use of:

- SWEDAC logo /ISO 13485 Certificates issued by Intertek Medical Notified Body

An Intertek Certified organization, under a SWEDAC accredited scheme, may use the SWEDAC accreditation logo and symbols only in conjunction with Intertek's symbol on the organisation's stationery and literature, and its advertising, subject to SWEDAC's and Intertek's conditions for use for the logos and symbols.

When referring to accreditation in a language other than Swedish, accepted terminology must be used, equivalent to the corresponding Swedish terms. The text in SWEDAC's accreditation mark must not be translated.

The SWEDAC accreditation symbol shall be reproduced:

- In either black and white or the colour scheme: blue with the colour CYMK 100.44.0.0, PMS 300, RGB 0.120.193 or HEX #0078c 1, and yellow with colour CMYK 0.30.100.0, PMS 7409, RGB 253.185.19 or HEX #fdb913, or in black or white, against a background providing good contrast
- Alternatively, the symbol may be printed or displayed in a single colour, which is the predominant ink colour of the document, or, in the case of a pre-printed letterhead, the predominant colour of the letterhead
- In a size (normally a minimum height of 20mm) that makes all features of the symbol distinguishable
- Without distortion of its proportions

The size of the SWEDAC symbol must not exceed the size of Intertek's symbol.

The organisation may not place the SWEDAC accreditation symbol in isolation from Intertek's symbol.
