While there are many changes associated with UL 1995 4th Edition, this quick guide highlights the top 5 that you need to be aware of to ensure your product is compliant by Intertek's deadline of February 27, 2015. - 1 Electric Heat Controllers: Electric heat controllers shall break all ungrounded conductors. Phase breaking is not permitted.
- **2** Contactors used in Pressure-limiting Circuits: Contactors used in pressure-limiting circuits shall have an endurance rating of 100,000 cycles or more.
- 3 Requirements for Certification on Electronically Protected Motor Circuits: The protective circuits shall meet specific requirements of the applicable UL/CSA standards based on the application and degree of protection.
- 4 **Loading Test on Ceiling and Wall Suspended Equipment:** The equipment must withstand up to three times its weight (no more than 400 lbs) for one minute.
- 5 Requirements for Units Utilizing Motors with Wave Chopping Solid State Speed Devices: Half wave test on motors required.
