Loading and discharge supervision

Cargo weighing supervision and draft surveys

Accurate, verified weighing at port terminals is essential for protecting the value of your cargo. Our global team of experts can supervise weighing on loading and discharge at ports all over in the world.

Weighing guidelines are product dependent and vary from country to country. Our onsite supervisors are able to negotiate local regulations and any specific requirements for your cargo. They will also verify the quality of measurement by checking scales are regularly calibrated, records properly maintained, and that there are valid certificates issued by competent authorities.

Our qualified surveyors can also carry out draft surveys, to further support weight information given on Bills of Lading. Using internationally accepted standards and accounting for local factors, our surveyors can

determine the weight of cargo by measuring the water displacement of a vessel before and after loading or discharge.

As a respected global operator, our weighing supervision and draft survey report services are widely used by major trading houses to protect their interests and avoid the risk of losses caused by inaccurate weighing.

Tank and hold cleanliness inspection/calibration

Understanding the condition of tanks and holds is vital for the safe shipping of your cargo. Contamination, infestation or damp could damage or destroy it, while refusal to load due to suspected cleanliness issues could be costly.

Our qualified inspectors check that holds and tanks are clean and dry, untainted by previous cargo and free from infestation. They verify, where possible, that hatches function, and assess whether there is adequate ventilation. They also make recommendations for stowage based on the specific cargo being transported.

An expert independent evaluation allows you to make informed decisions and if necessary, effectively negotiate with ship owners for measures to be taken to preserve your goods, and your investment.
