

SCIP DATABASE: A STEP BY STEP CHECKLIST

The following information provides a high-level checklist for companies placing products on the market that contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs). As of 05 January 2021, products that contain SVHCs in a concentration greater than 0.1% (w/w) must be reported to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) via the SCIP Database. The legal basis for this requirement is the EU Waste Framework Directive (2008/98/EC).

To place products on the market that contain SVHCs, you must:

- 1. Determine if you are required to submit your articles to the SCIP Database (manufacturer, importer, distributor)
- 2. Group your articles according to the SCIP database requirements to reduce time and effort
- 3. Collect information about the articles (suppliers, datasheets, test reports, etc.)
- 4. Evaluate incoming information identify which articles should be submitted to the SCIP Database
- 5. Create IUCLID dossiers
- 6. Submit dossiers to ECHA and generate SCIP numbers
- 7. Maintain data
